Did you know the point values for Extreme Cowboy Races and how you qualify for the World Championships?

World Point Qualifying Events: Single (WPQ) or Double Point (DWPQ)

- No more than two WPQ or DWPQ events may be held at one location in a single weekend.
- No WPQ event will be allowed to take place on the same weekend as the Regional Championship within the same Region.
- There shall be a maximum of two (2) judges for any EXCA event.
- When using two (2) judges, the two judge's scores will be totaled and divided by 2 to determine the score given to the horse/rider team for that go of the event.

EXCA Cowboy Classic (Triple Points)

- Any current EXCA Affiliated Club can apply to host an EXCA Cowboy Classic event.
- Must be pre-approved
- Must be in conjunction with another major event, i.e. a State Fair

EXCA State Championships (Double Points)

- State Championship dates and location shall be approved by the EXCA.
- Each State may have one State Championship event.
- Any EXCA member may compete in a State Championship.
- A State Championship shall be a standalone event.

EXCA Regional Championships (Triple Points)

- Each Region shall have one Regional Championship.
- Regional Championships dates and location shall be approved by the EXCA and may be held anytime throughout the year (prior to the World Championship).
- Any EXCA member may compete in the Regional Championship.
- A Regional Championship shall be a standalone event.
- Regional Championship events should use at least one (1) Level 3 judge

EXCA International/Provincial and Championship Series (Five Times Points) - Includes the National Championships

- International/Provincial Championship dates and location shall be

approved by the EXCA.

- Each Country/Province may have one International/Provincial Championship event.
- Any EXCA member may compete in an International/Provincial Championship.
- An International/Provincial Championship shall be a standalone event.

EXCA World Championship

- The date and location of the EXCA World Championship shall be determined by EXCA office.
- Qualification to compete in the EXCA World Championship requires that the horse /rider team must rank in the top 60% of their Division in the National Points standings.
- A horse may be substituted for the World competition only with a written confirmation by a veterinarian that the horse is out for the competition season. A substitute horse must not have won a Division title at the EXCA World Championship within the last three years.

Judge's Forum - You asked, the judges

answered!

Question: When does a horse have to quit the green horse category? After one season, after a certain number of contest, never? Does the rider that ride a green horse have to go in at least the intermediate category, because it is difficult to admit that a novice could present a green horse?

Answer: Regarding the "green horse" *this is a non point earning class (no EXCA records kept on the horses that choose to compete in this class). The current eligibility rules for this class dictate that any horse that has not competed in an official EXCA class may show in this event. Because it is 1) a non point earning class, 2) the allowed obstacles are comparably simple and unchallenging, and 3) the rider cannot use it in any other class, horse don't typically remain in this class very long - they either show they are ready to move up or demonstrate they are not right for the sport. There are exceptions to every rule; I have occasionally heard that an area downgraded the prizes (and offered little, if any, prize money) compared to the regular classes so there was no incentive to stay in the class. *there is no age limit, show limit, win limit, or time limit for continued eligibility - if the horse has not been exhibited in another class by any rider, it remains theoretically eligible. Once it shows in any other EXCA class, it cannot be shown in a green horse class - regardless of time, rider, skill level. * any rider aged 12 or older may show a horse in the Green Horse class. There is no assumed level of skill for that rider, which means that a Novice may indeed exhibit (and often does, without penalty or assumption they should then not be able to continue to show as a novice). There are a great many reasons for a rider to choose to exhibit a horse in the Green Horse division rather than an official class - that is why EXCA chose to offer this option.
