Top Horse Competition Features Many ECXA Riders!

For three days each winter in Kansas the Equine industry and enthusiasts come together to celebrate all things horses. Every discipline and breed imaginable can be found at the event. For the past four years there has been a very unique competition that has taken place. The R Bar B Top Horse Versatility Challenge is designed to challenge a rider and their horse to five very different classes of competition to crown one champion.

In 2019 there were nine amazing riders that competed and eight of the nine were ECXA members. We had current and former World Champions, National Champions long with Calgary Stampede Champions in the mix to win the Top Horse distinction. The Top Horse challenge truly is a challenge for both rider and horse as they are asked to compete in five distinct challenges. This year the riders competed in an Extreme Barrel race, a jumping derby (in western tack), a cowboy obstacle race, a

reining and cow work class, and the ever popular freestyle competition. The riders must use the same horse for all five classes spread out over three days. We had riders from as far away as Texas come to compete this year.

The Top Horse competition is unique in its design and challenge for each rider. Craig Cameron, creator of EXCA, is always talking about unspecializing the specialized horse and the Top Horse competition is an excellent venue to show that exact sentiment. The horses and riders must be a great team to succeed and be willing to try new and different types of competition. The competitors are predominantly cowboy obstacle racers, the reason- other disciplines are not as willing to take their horses out of their specialized training, where as cowboy racers are used to asking their horses to trust them and try new things.

In 2019 we were excited to see all the fans, often in the thousands, that came out to watch the amazing lineup of competitors. This was a very unique year as well, in that a very different team won each class. Another new thing we did this year is that we invited Kansas youth to do exhibitions in each of the classes. All the youth that exhibited, with the exception of the jumping derby, are all current EXCA youth riders and they put on a tremendous show of what the future holds!

A few years ago one of our family members received a diagnosis that was life altering for this strong man. Joel Mobley was diagnosed in 2017 with Multiple Sclerosis, an often debilitating disease that affects the central nervous system. Joel and his wife, Barb, have tried countless medications and treatments to help Joel deal with the effects the disease has taken on his health. Anyone who has ever been to a race where Joel has announced, competed or even just been there, knows the effect Joel has on riders and spectators. He has always been a tremendous positive supporter for any person that rode in a race. Joel is always willing to impart his horse knowledge to anyone that takes the time to listen. He is an amazing horseman and person all around with a faith that we should all aspire to have.

A few months ago a group of dedicated EXCA veterans came together with an idea to help a member of the family. A benefit for Joel and Barb Mobley as they fight this diagnosis with everything they have. It took us a few weeks to iron out details and get the word out but it didn't take long for the family to show massive amounts of support. We announced the August 3rd and 4th benefit race on Facebook and within 10 minutes had 42 riders already committed, even before we had settled on the entry fee prices. As of now we had 78 riders committed to the event. On top of that we have had clubs from all
